

Campus Visit Checklist

Visit when school is in session to experience the real environment.

- _____ Obtain a schedule so you can plan to sit in on classes.
- _____ Prepare a list of questions in advance.
- _____ Make an appointment with the admissions office. Share a list of your high school courses and grades so you'll get an estimate of how you stack up against other applicants.
- _____ Schedule a campus tour. Ask to see facilities that are important to you, such as science labs or athletic facilities. Ask questions of the guide, such as what he or she likes or dislikes about the school.
- _____ Pick up a copy of the school newspaper.
- _____ Check out bulletin boards to find out about activities on campus.
- _____ Spend time observing and talking to other students. Consider whether you want to be part of this student body.
- _____ Visit the student center to check out services and facilities.
- _____ Arrange to talk to students in the major you are interested in. Ask questions about the strength and weaknesses of the program.
- _____ Eat in the dining facility.
- _____ Visit a dorm or another student housing option. What choices do you have?
